Direct Church Relief Aid Department (Kerygma), utilized with great care the contribution offered by everyone for church' reconstruction, so that it would fully fulfill its purpose.

The content of this relief aid, was to deliver condolence money to churches which received damage on their church building, to pay for the church' reconstruction and large scale renovation, give out relief aid to church member who suffered great damage, giving pastoral aid to churches suffering from nuclear power plant accident, and to aid the relief activity carried out by the church network. We deeply appreciate for all the precious contribution from many churches and individuals for the work. The contributions from everyone helped to reconstruct churches, encouraged, and advanced the pastoral activity.

The contribution to Direct Church Relief Aid Department was brought to an end by the end of 2013. The reason this was brought to an end was because we understand that this Direct Church Relief Aid was for emergency support, and it has now completed its function. We appreciate for all the prayers and the precious contributions from our hearts. Thank you very much.

Last year, Touhoku HELP was approved officially as a Non-Profit Organization. There is a great need for relief aid at the disaster affected areas, and it is necessary to keep up the relief activity for the work of church network, though not limiting the aid to certain religions. So if anyone contributes to the Direct Church Relief Aid after year-end of 2013, we would utilize this for the church network relief aid. I would like you to remember the work done here.

March 2011

-Emergency Support decision by the plenary meeting

May 2011

-Organize Donation Allocation Committee

June 2011

-Contribution application for damaged church building was sent to the churches in disaster affected areas.
-Condolence money provided (application period ended in August)

July 2011

-A field survey was conducted by the committee member to those churches which has been reported that it received large-scale damage.

August 2011

-Contribution application was sent and contribution was provided to churches in the disaster affected areas, for loss of church member' lives. (Application period ended in January 2012)

January 2012

-Pastoral support application for nuclear power plant accident was sent (700 copies) (application period ended in June 2013)
-Large scale hutch building' renovation aid (ended in March 2013)

February 2012

-Church network relief aid

Conference was held by the Committee for the above written reason (32 times), and contribution was distributed. Year and month abbreviated.
